

MR. RACHMANINOFF PLAYS.

Sergei Rachmaninoff, Russian composer and pianist, played his own third piano concerto yesterday afternoon at a concert of the Symphony Society in Carnegie Hall. He had played it earlier in the season with telling effect in Aeolian Hall and repeated his success yesterday.

The orchestra, directed by Walter Damrosch, played Tschaikowsky's "Pathetique" symphony and Chadwick's "Aphrodite" symphonic poem. The tone of the strings in the symphony was exceptionally fine and the whole work went with more force and life than the average performance of the Symphony Orchestra.
