For an hour Mr. Williams was permitted to talk without interruption. He talked of the days when Kerensky fought to retain power, and after that discoursed at length on the Soviet and the present government. He pointed out that the people rule in Russia and that there is an election to the All-Russian Soviet every three months; and that when these All-Russian Soviets meet they do not brand that testimony as false. He intimated that those witnesses gained their information from members of the upper classes of society, who he intimated were "not very happy" under Bolshevik rule.

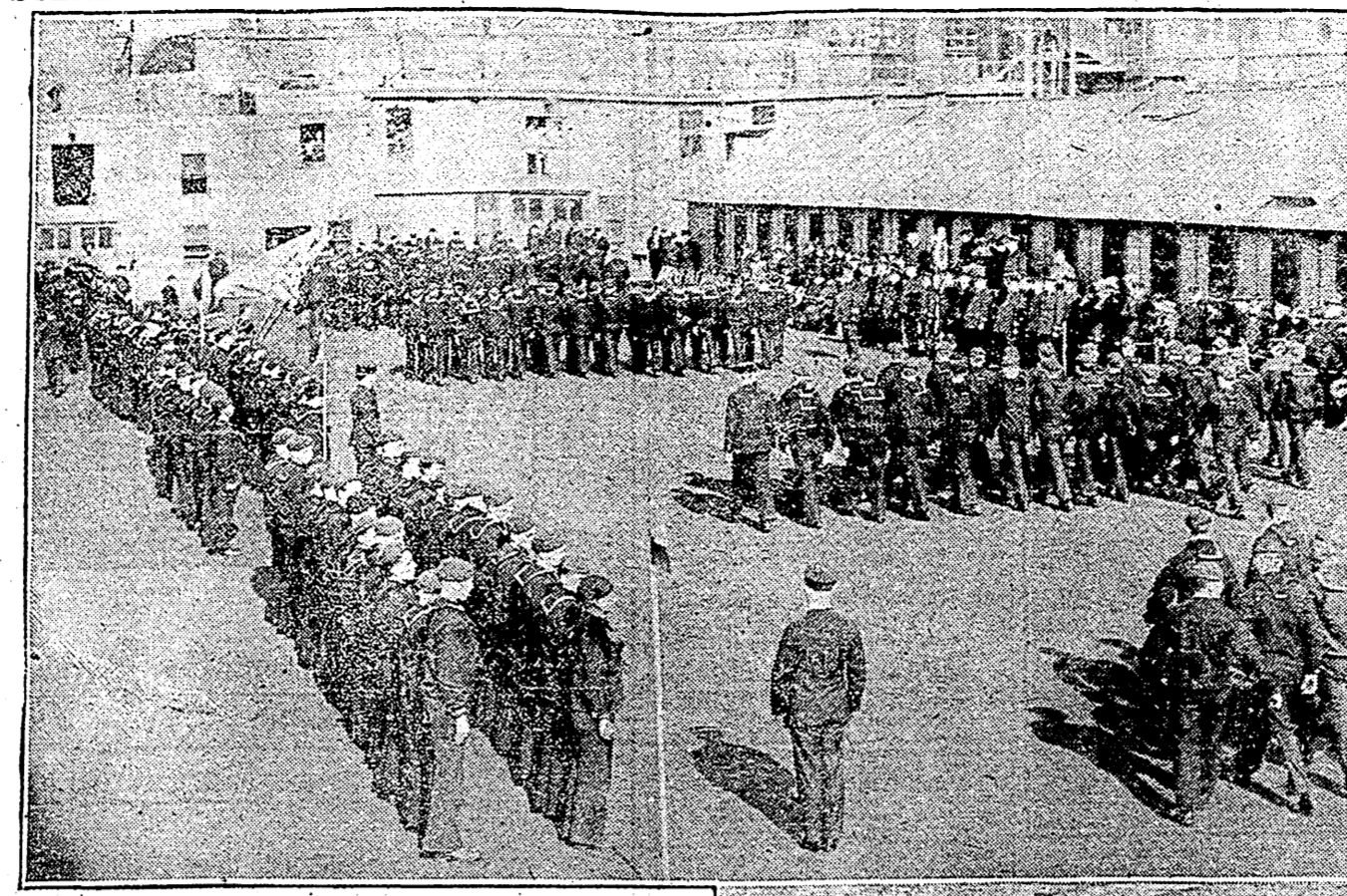
HOOPER PLEADS TO HELP FRED PEOPLES

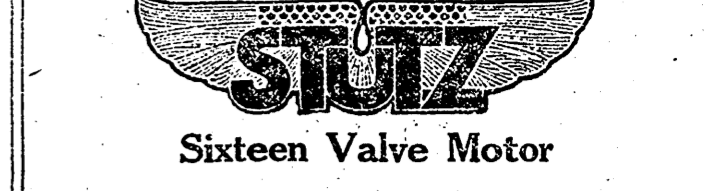
