

SERGEI RACHMANINOFF IN SYMPHONY HALL RECITAL

Sergel Rachmanioff, the noted Russian composer and pianist, gave a recital yesterday afternoon in Symphony Hall to a numerous and enthusiastic audience. The announced program included an andantino and variations, by Schubert, transcribed by Tausig; Schumann's "Davidsbündler" dances, opus 6; Chopin's scherzo in B minor, followed by the one in B flat minor, an interesting juxtaposition; two pieces by the pianist himself, and three by Liszt.

Mr Rachmaninoff's reputation as a concert pianist is so long established, and so great, that there is nothing further left for a reviewer to write about him, except that his hold on the public remains a strong one.
