Sergei Rachmaninoff gave a concert for the student dormitory in Lund last night in the Lund University auditorium. Unfortunately, he had a comparatively small audience, probably 150 to 200 people; but since the ticket prices were high, down in the hall 10 SEK, there should at least be a thousand in savings for the good cause.

The audience's enjoyment of the evening was of course also considerable. The program was large and its content very valuable and it was performed with splendour and brilliance. One does not know what to admire most in Mr. Rachmaninoff, the clear expression of this art or the crystal-clear purity of feeling that speaks when he plays, for example, Chopin or Rubinstein, not to mention his own compositions, of which he preferred a number. He was met with a hearty welcome and received flowers from the boarding school committee.
